Meeting was called to order at 9:04 am - A quorum of nine (9) voting members was present.

Communication/Correspondence: None at this time

Approval of Minutes: Jerry Allen made a motion to approve the minutes for February 7, 2019. David Skelton seconded the motion. Motion passed (9-0)

Financial/Grant updates:

- a. SERC Grant – has been submitted. No conformation has been received as of this meeting.
- b. UWS Grant –(\$25,000.00) This grant focuses on terrorism and items/equipment are used by law enforcement. The items discussed were an additional Reader Board machine. (\$14,000 to \$15,000) and an additional Drone (\$10,000). David Skelton made a motion to apply for these items in the 2020 UWS grant. Star Gentry seconded the motion. Motion passed (9-0)

Update on Communications: Sheriff Allen reports that Dispatch console is at its max – 1980 equipment – This item was not approved for the upcoming budget. The second 911 console went down and a new hard drive was ordered. They are hoping to get it repaired. Sheriff Allen is also researching any grant sources that could help with these budget shortfalls.

Training Schedule Update: Charlie Sparke will check with Rodney Wilcox if the Table Top meeting hosted by the Rye Patch Fire Department scheduled for tonight is still going. The main topic for this meeting will be Wild Fire/ Fuel Tank scenarios. Nuclear Shipment training was discussed. Trainings were held in Elko, Reno and Winnemucca. Charlie Sparke attended the trainings in Reno and Winnemucca. The need for one here was discussed. Also discussed were the big differences in resources and response methods in the urban as compared to the rural areas.

Staff/Board Reports. Charlie Sparke said that he will be picking up the Plan Book next Tuesday with will make sure Cheryl with the Health Department has a copy.
